You can also print a copy by selecting the **View and Print Your Student** Aid Report option under the FAFSA Follow-up section of the home page.

If you did not provide an e-mail address, we will mail you a paper 2007-2008 SAR.

C. Enter our address into your e-mail address book.

Some e-mail providers will only deliver messages to your inbox if the sender's address is listed in your address book. Please add our originating address to your address book: FederalStudentAidFAFSA@cpsemail.ed.gov.

D. Making corrections to your FAFSA

If you find you've made a mistake after submitting your 2007-2008 application, you will have to wait until after your application has been processed to make corrections. If you have a PIN, you can access and correct your processed FAFSA information on the home page.
